

RED FLIGHT ~ \$19

2023 Rombauer Merlot ~ Napa Valley, CA 14.8% ABV \$65

Ripe black plum, black tea and mint aromas mingle in the glass with subtle scents of spice, freshly baked pie crust, and vanilla. Cherry and plum flavors with a touch of mint and hint of spice, all giving way to notes of dark chocolate and vanilla. Its signature palate is framed by very fine, yet soft tannins and a refreshing length, enhanced by its acidity.

2021 Sean Minor “Rossi Ranch” Grenache ~ Sonoma Valley, CA 15.5% ABV \$66

A tempting cherry-chocolate aroma and warm, plummy flavors make this full-bodied and moderately tannic wine broadly appealing. The slightly chewy texture nicely backs up the ripe, cooked berry and plum flavors for great balance.

2019 Kokomo Malbec ~ Dry Creek Valley, CA 14.3% ABV \$33

A rich ruby red color that shines through the glass and a nose full of violet, plum, and cassis. When it hits the palate it has big tannins that will soften over time, but are still very well balanced with big lush flavors of dark berry intertwined with notes of spice and bitter chocolate.

2021 The Calling Cabernet Sauvignon ~ Paso Robles, CA 14% ABV \$30

Rich and complex aromas with layers of ripe blackberry fruit, mocha, and warm vanilla spice with subtle hints of nutmeg. The flavors are bold with notes of cherry pie, coffee and a rich warm and spicy oak finish.

WHITE FLIGHT ~ \$13

2023 Poggio Del Moro Ivole ~ Toscana Bianco, Italy 13% ABV \$20

On the nose, a fresh, crisp bouquet of plum, pear, and melon along with a touch of nuttiness. Lighthearted, mineral notes of wildflowers and herbs linger on the palate towards a finish that sparkles with hints of lemon and orange.

2024 La Cabriole Chenin Blanc ~ Saumer, France 11% ABV \$17

Features high acidity, chalky minerality and notes of flowers, straw, and honey. It is a versatile, dry option, often praised for its refreshing profile.

2022 Vina Gonzalez Bastias ~ Maule Valley, Chile 12% ABV \$33

A vibrant orange wine made from a blend of Torontel, Moscatel, and País grapes; exhibiting wonderful finesse in its flavor and structure. The nose is aromatic, with delicate notes of peach and white flowers. The palate is light and fresh, with a well-balanced texture.

2019 Project M Schlussel ~ Willamette Valley AVA, OR 11.5% ABV \$

Honeysuckle and jasmine notes slowly rise from the glass followed by wafts of fresh-cut green melon, peach, and dried grass. Firm white peaches and Satsuma-like citrus span a spectrum from fresh to marmalade.
